What is the HRC?

The Human Relations Commission serves as an advisory board to Troy's Mayor, City Council, and staff.

The Commission's purpose is to:

- Study the problems that affect diverse groups within Troy, and the way those groups relate to one another. Those relationships may involve age, race, handicaps, socioeconomic level, or gender.
- Engage community cooperation to combat misunderstanding, prejudice, intolerance and bigotry.
- Collaborate with governmental agencies and schools to further community education on issues that affect diverse groups in Troy.
- Receive complaints related to discrimination, and learn from residents to assemble data about discrimination related to age, handicap, poverty, race or sex.
- Work with public and private employers to establish nondiscriminatory recruitment, hiring, and employee retention practices.
