Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area

Welcome to Troy's Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area! Please familiarize yourself with the DORA rules and enjoy our downtown.

FAQs:

Q: Can I bring my own drink into the DORA?

A: No. Patrons cannot bring their own alcoholic drink into the DORA. You can purchase your favorite drink in a marked DORA container from a participating establishment. Pre-packaged beverages are not permitted to be dispensed as a DORA beverage.

Q: Can I take my DORA beverage from one liquor establishment into another?

A: No. Per ORC 4321.06, you cannot take a DORA drink back into the liquor establishment where you purchased it after exiting or into another liquor establishment.

Q: Can I take my DORA beverage into my favorite shop?

A: Yes, if a retailer indicates that they allow DORA beverages by displaying a green DORA decal, you can shop with your drink!

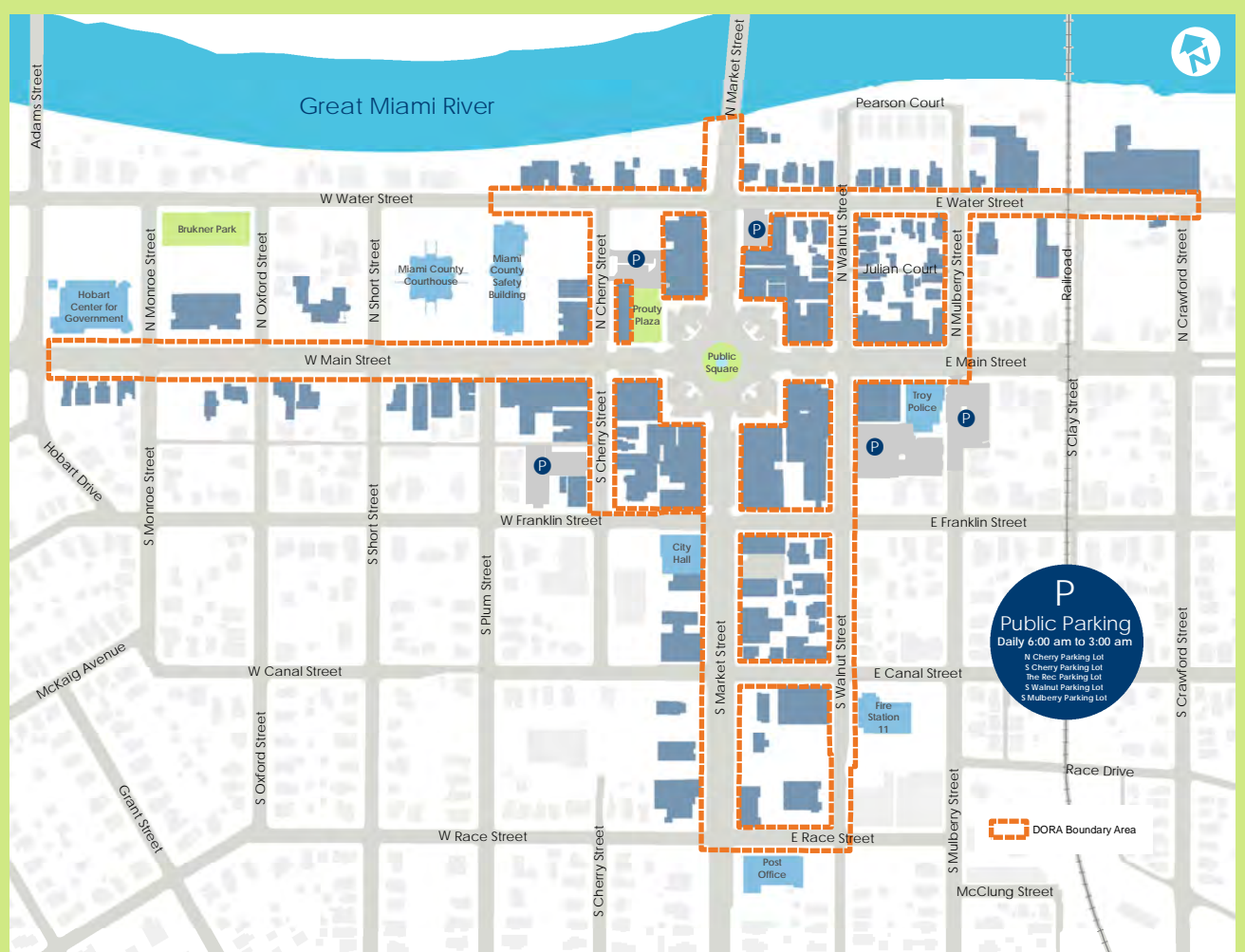
Q: How will the DORA be enforced?

A: Troy police staff will monitor the DORA area during routine patrols. If you need assistance, please contact the Troy Police Department at 911.

All liquor regulations apply to establishments and patrons within the DORA, including overserving and drunk driving laws. Please drink responsibly.

DORA Rules:

- Outdoor consumption of alcohol is permitted only during DORA hours: **11 a.m. to 11 p.m. daily.**
- DORA beverages are only permitted within DORA boundaries.
- Patrons must be 21 years of age or older.
- DORA beverages must be purchased at a bar or restaurant located within the DORA boundaries.
- DORA beverages must be consumed from marked DORA containers. Consumption from other vessels is prohibited.
- Containers must be disposed of before patrons enter another liquor establishment.
- DORA beverages may only be carried into stores displaying a green decal indicating that DORA beverages are welcome.
